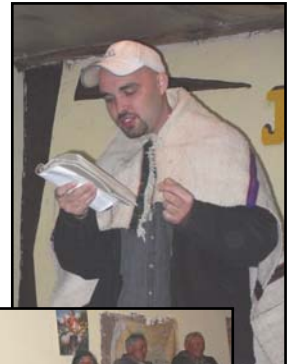


**Greetings in the name of King Jesus!** I trust this newsletter finds you blessed and highly favored.

**Since I last wrote you, I had the tremendously awesome opportunity to head 5 hours outside of Lima into the mountains in the province of Tarma, where a fellow Canadian missionary from my home church in Peterborough, Ontario ministers alongside her Peruvian husband. Some weeks ago she extended an e-mail invitation asking me if I'd like to come out there and teach on –you guessed it—the Holy Spirit.**

**Only on the first night of the three did I actually preach on that subject because God had other plans.** Ultimately, many people in the group of maybe 25 individuals received the baptism in the Holy Spirit for their first time. The next night, I felt led by God to change topics. I felt like He gave me a message out of 2nd Kings for the next fellowship which was in an even more remote location than the first night; we took a winding highway up in the mountains, then got on a dirt road and followed it for at least half an hour.

**These precious saints who gathered for the meeting were really receptive to the message I had that night—on the spot—on the love of God.** They asked me to share my testimony, and once I began, I wound up abandoning my “word” from 2 Kings. For the first time in my life, I preached a totally extemporaneous message with no notes. I enjoyed myself and it seemed to really reach these peoples’ hearts. I was honored for God to have used me in that way—sharing primarily on the love of God and how much He actually delights in His children.



**The final night, Sunday, was yet another topic.** This time I followed some notes prepared beforehand on healing. I'm waiting to hear back from Denise to make sure some of the testimonies are still valid and that the birds of the air were not successful in stealing the seed away after these people experienced genuine healing miracles in their bodies. I would keep asking those who received prayer if they could do something to make sure pain was gone or they could verify the healing had taken place. Towards the end two ladies both received prayer and healing by faith for gallbladder issues and were excited that other pain in their bodies had disappeared.
