I've had my heartstrings tugged on before as we've visited the various feeding programs Ron Smith oversees all over the country, but **there was something even more humbling to wash the feet of children and share the love of God** verbally (as best I could in Spanish, of course) and through such an act. It was even more heartbreaking to witness many of the people waiting in a long line outside the door to the dirt-floor church trying to break down the door to make sure they had a chance to obtain a pair of shoes for their kid. We also had to have police clear a pathway for us to make it out the door of the church to the bus without being mobbed. It was a very sobering reminder of many things I'm used to taking for granted in the west.



This year's *United in The Fire Of God* conference is next month! Author, speaker, radio & TV show host Michael L. Brown will be the guest speaker. You may remember this time last year Fire Peru was raising money to translate and print a book of his called "*It's Time For Holy Fire/Es Tiempo Para El Fuego Santo*".
